

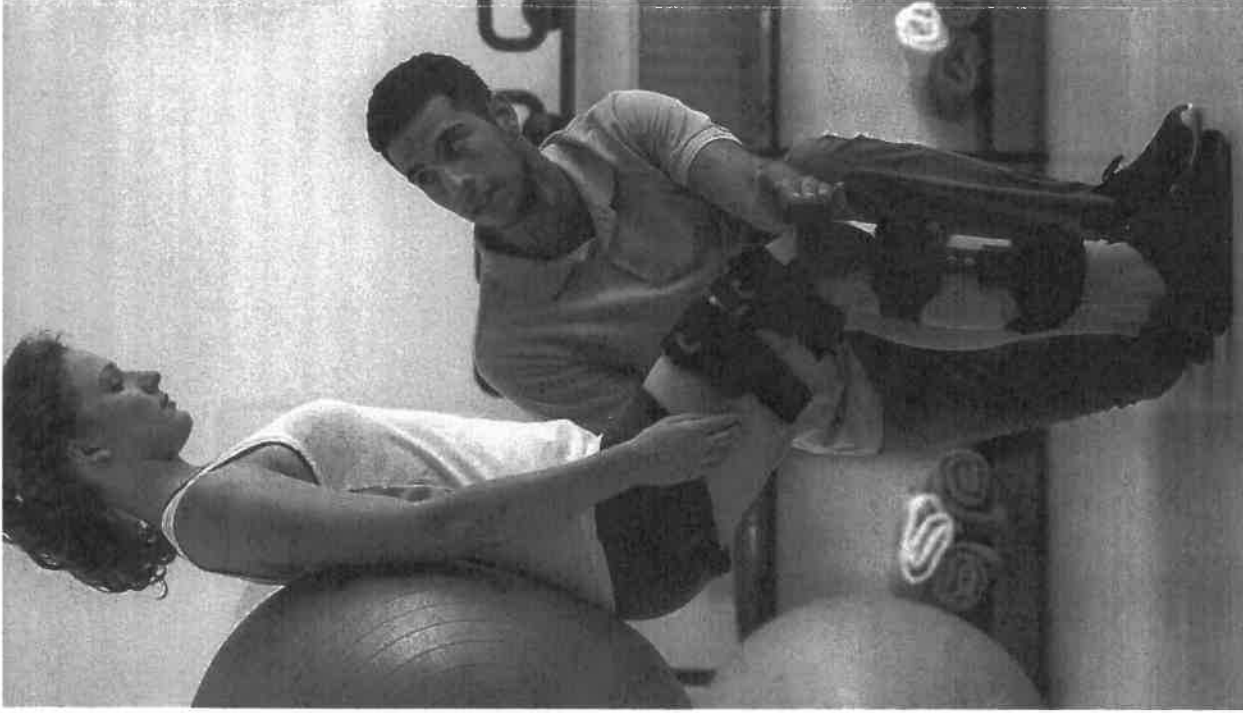
Learn from the experts at Nationwide Children's Hospital Sports Medicine.

The Athletic Training Workshop is designed for high school students interested in athletic training, physical therapy or other allied health professions. No experience is necessary.

The Certified Athletic Trainer is an allied health care professional that is certified by the Board of Certification (BOC). Athletic Trainers serve as a liaison to the athlete, coach, physician and other members of the healthcare team.

- CPR & first-aid training
- Hands-on taping labs with lecture sessions
