Please call the LV Primary office at 763-2865, to make an appointment for your child.


Kindergarten students must be 5 on or before August 1st and a resident of the district.

The Licking Valley Girls Track Team wrapped up their indoor season with strong performances at the Central District Indoor Meet and Division II/ III Indoor State Meet. The team finished 5th out of 24 teams at the CDI Meet and 18th out of 112 teams at the Indoor State Meet. Scoring at the CDI were: Mackenzie Butler - 1st in the 800; Hannah Gearhart - 3rd in the weight throw and 7th in shot; Aurora Chalfant - 4th in the weight throw; Natalie Hurst - 5th in the Pole Vault; Haylee Zigan - 6th in the 3200 with a new LV Indoor School Record; The 5th place 4x800 of Zigan, Hurst, Bethany Rutherford, and Butler; The 4th place 4x400 of Cara Dillon, Hurst, Regan Bebout, and Butler; and the 8th place 4x2 of Dillon, Hurst, Bebout, and Abbie Gossett. The 3200 Relay of Zigan, Hurst, Rutherford, and Dillon were 16th at the State Meet while Mackenzie Butler finished 2nd in the 1600 and 6^{th} in the 800.
