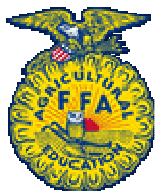

LV FFA Parliamentary Procedure Team

The Licking Valley FFA Parliamentary Procedure team took top honors by placing 1st in the annual county contest November 22 at Johnstown High School. The top team from each county moves on to the district competition which will be held at Clearfork High School on December 1st.



In the contest, participants must properly demonstrate a business meeting. They are given six abilities and three motions to accomplish during the 15 minute time allotment. The members must discuss main motions and the certain abilities, as to whether they are for the motion or against it. Participants must also take a test on various rules of parliamentary procedure and are scored on FFA official dress. FFA chapter teams from Johnstown and Utica also competed.
