- It's been 18 years since Licking Valley has asked for operating dollars.
- Residents are only paying 5.22 mil of the 8.9 mil High School Bond issue (3.68 reduction).

School districts throughout Ohio are participating in an effort to identify, locate and evaluate all children with disabilities birth through age 21. By disability, we mean conditions such as multiple disabilities, hearing impairment, visual impairment, orthopedic impairment, other health impairment, emotional disturbance, cognitive disability, specific learning disability, speech and/or language disability, autism and traumatic brain injury. Many children with disabilities are not visible because they do not function in the main stream of the community. Also, many unidentified children with disabilities are preschoolers. Parents may not be aware that programs and services are available. 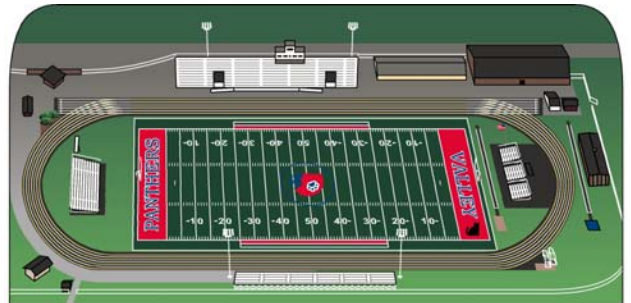

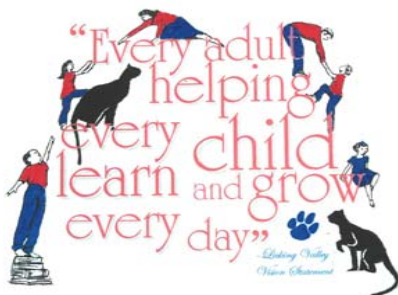
