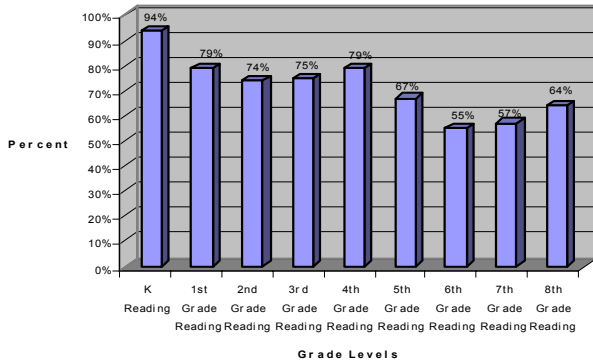

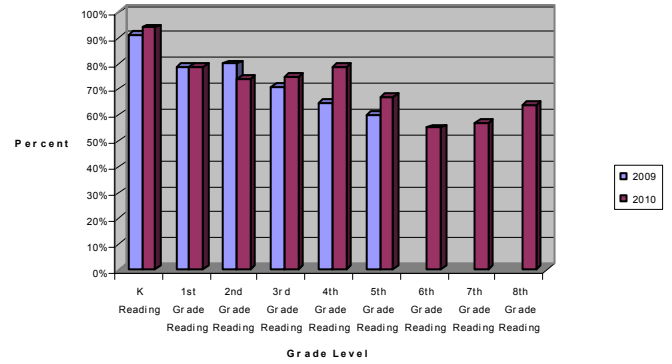

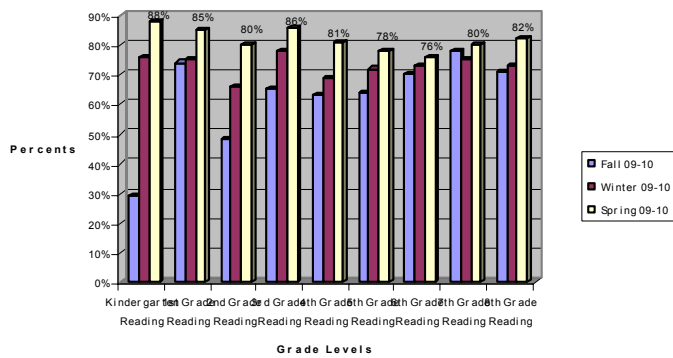
Meeting Reading Growth Target 2010



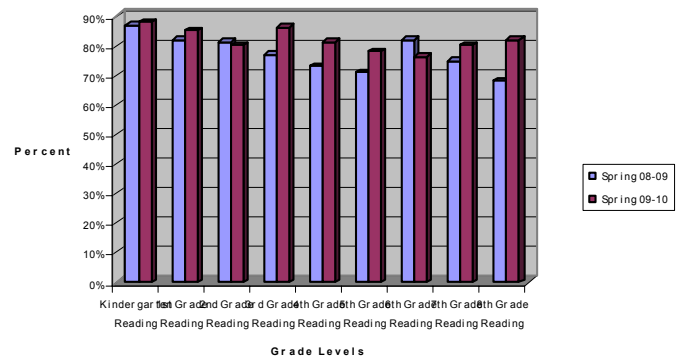
Students Meeting Growth Targets - Reading Trend



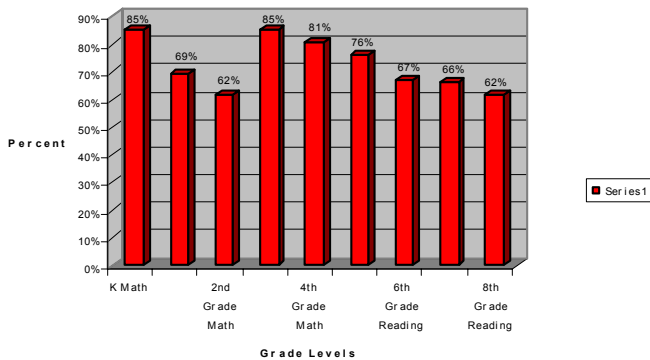
Reading on Grade Level 2010



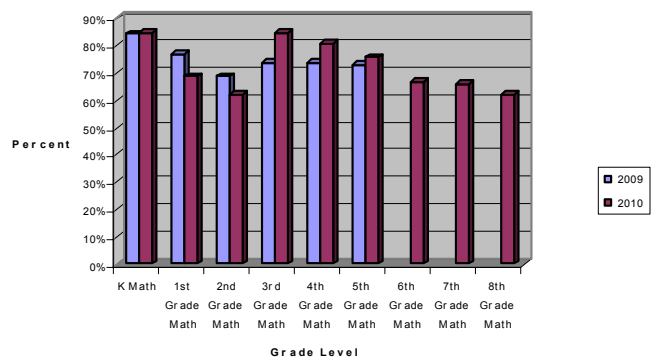
On Grade Level Reading Trend



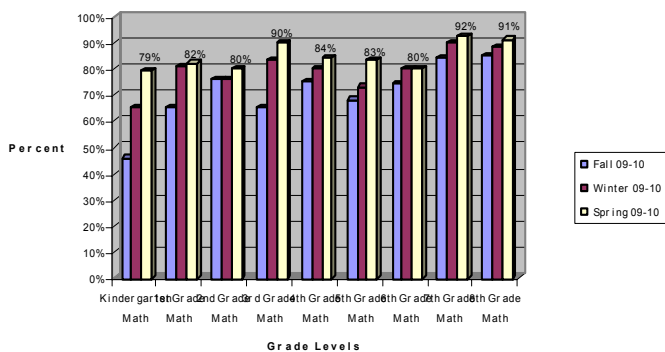
Meeting Math Growth Target 2010



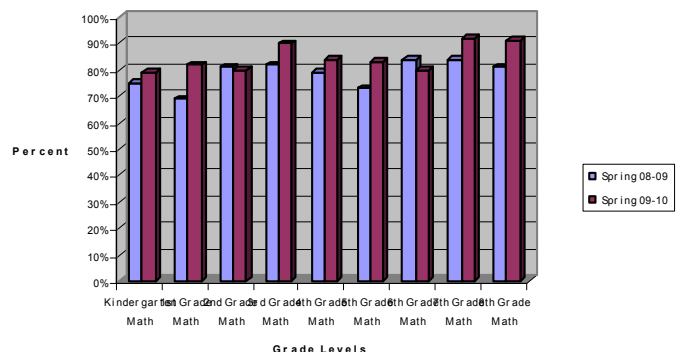
Students Meeting Growth Target - Math Trend

On Grade Level Math Trend

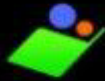
