LVHS Physical Education Staff Chosen for Pilot Program

Last spring, the LVHS Physical Education staff was selected to take part in a pilot program conducted by ODE. The goal of the program was to examine, practice, and evaluate the effectiveness of the new PE assessment standards that are being ushered in by Senate Bill 210. Beginning in the Fall of 2012, each school will be required by the state to turn in data on their evaluations of students in the 6 standards (2 benchmarks per standard, 12 total assessments). These results will then be included on the state report card.

Students will be assessed on each standard and scored with three possible levels of performance – a 3, 2, 1 system for each benchmark. Advanced/ Exceeded outcome (3), Proficient/Met outcome (2), and Limited/Did not meet outcome (1).

The purpose of the new assessment protocol is to find a better way to assess how our students are learning and achieving the standards. The ultimate goal is for PE teachers across the state to be able to show evidence of the learning that is taking place in their classrooms. This is monumental because never before has there been a state-wide vehicle to assess student learning in P.E.

High School P.E. teacher Robin Miller will be presenting on this topic at the Annual OAHPERD Convention in December.
